Registration Membership Agreement

Fall 2008 - Summer 2009

Parental Release (Parent/Guardian must read and agree below)

Once rosters are received and final payment is submitted by the due date, my player is committed to the Dakota REV Soccer Club for the 2008 Fall Season, will be formally registered with the Minnesota Youth Soccer Association (MYSA) and may not register with another club or organization affiliated with MYSA without first petitioning Dakota REV for an Interclub Transfer. The supplemental health and liability insurance benefits from registration of my player with MYSA and Dakota REV may not apply to activities not sanctioned by MYSA and Dakota REV (e.g., indoor leagues). Dakota REV is a competitively oriented soccer club. Playing time is earned, not given. Players who, over time, do not demonstrate an ability to compete at their team's competitive level may be released from that team. Placement on a Dakota REV team is determined by criteria that includes playing ability, level of commitment, availability of playing positions, etc. Dakota REV coaches/evaluators will evaluate players' performance over a period of time before placement on a team. Parents are expected to fill various roles as volunteers for the annual Dakota REV Soccer Tournament.

Additionally, as a Parent of a Dakota REV Soccer Club Player, I/we will set a good example to my/our child in his/her soccer development by adhering at all times to following Dakota REV Parent Pledge:

I/we will set a good example to my/our child in his/her soccer development by adhering at all times to the following:

- I will give only positive feedback to players.
- I shall leave the coaching to the coach during the game and will not give my child instructions during the game.
- I will not criticize the referee openly or directly, during or after games. Any criticism shall be done in writing, sent to my manager or my club representative, not verbally.
- I will not make negative comments about the game, coaches, referees or teammates in my child's presence. I understand that this plants a seed, which can negatively influence my child's motivation and overall experience.
- I will cheer at all games within the spirit of fair play without regard to the outcome.
- I will do my best to have my child prepared for every game. I will be on time or early when dropping off my child for a practice or game. I understand that it is embarrassing for my child to be late to a game or practice and I understand I am putting him/her at physical risk by not providing adequate time for warmup.
- I shall support the learning efforts of the players, coaches and referees by demonstrating patience.
- I understand that improper behavior at a game may result in a parent being asked to leave the field by the referee or a club official so the coach does not receive a yellow card or a red card ejection due to the actions of a spectator.
- I understand that the club or league can, and will if necessary, suspend my individual privilege to watch my child play should I behave in a manner that is rude or otherwise offensive.
- I agree to do my best to have as much fun watching the game as the players should have playing the game.

Finally, I, the parent/guardian of the minor player, also agree that the player and I will abide by the rules of Dakota REV, MYSA and USYSA and their affiliated organizations and sponsors. Recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with soccer and in consideration for USYSA, MYSA and Dakota REV accepting the player for its soccer program and activities, I hereby release, discharge and/or otherwise indemnify Dakota REV, USYSA and MYSA, its affiliated organizations and sponsors, their employees, volunteers, and associated personnel, including the owners of the fields and facilities utilized for the program, from any and all claims by or on behalf of the player and the undersigned as a result of the player's participation in the program and/or being transported to or from the same, which transportation I hereby authorize.
